Procedure:	- Watching documentaries or short films about the behavior in a factory/firm where there are different rules that they need to respect, but there are also presented interpersonal relationships, empathy, making friendships etc. - Acting in pairs on a chosen scene of the movie in which a given social skill is used.
Conditions:	Choosing the appropriate films
Variation/addition	They are given specific tasks that they should play in pairs and/or groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to schedule an examination - to take out a document - to get a train/bus ticket - to find a place he wants to visit and so on
